A call for entries for the main exhibition! (<u>https://bookplate2022.org/competition-</u>2022) Given the important "book arts" movement underway today in San Francisco, it is appropriate to turn our focus to the book arts for our main exhibition. Please note we offer an "open" competition invitation for the congress exhibition of contemporary world ex libris. Outstanding ex libris prints created between 2020-2022 are welcome (and encouraged)! During the Congress in San Francisco our focus is on the book arts — books, book piles, bookplates, libraries, printing presses, papermaking, bookbinding, etc. Perhaps a favorite author or book collecting interest. Even the brief but colorful life of Jack London who, in his time,

made a fortune as a writer (<u>https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Jack\_London</u>). San Francisco and our Centennial Celebration will be of special interest too. After San Francisco this exhibition will not go into a dark storage room! Instead, it will tour libraries across the nation. We will maximize the exposure for all participating artists.

Given that the *fisae.org* annual renewal went unpaid we proceeded to build a unique website for the San Francisco congress. **YES**, we have a congress website for the "**Bookplates By The Bay**" **FISAE Congress in 2022** (*https://bookplate2022.org*). It is now up & running, but it is a slow process since money remains a big point of contention to complete the site and our webmaster is building the site in his spare time. I do understand that comprehensive websites run \$10,000-20,000 USD and more! No one understands this until they decide to build a website (they must think websites come from a heaven sent miracle!?). Then it must be constantly monitored and maintained. And renewed every year. So website expenses are <u>ongoing everyday</u>!

Registration fees will be determined once we know exactly how much we receive in donations to our non-profit organization. We are providing a very attractive, tax-deductible option for Americans to sponsor events at our congress rather than surrendering their hard-earned money to Washington every year! **"Bookplates By The Bay**" is a publicly supported, non-profit educational organization (just like the ASBC&D) and global ex libris artists & collectors will enjoy the benefits. We'll know early in 2022. **ALL major credit cards will be accepted** for registrations. Certainly this will streamline the registration process!

Sunday the 11th the fun begins with registration and orientation for our guests at the Waterfront Hotel at Jack London Square (<u>https://bookplate2022.org/waterfront-hotel</u>).

**On Monday the 12th and Wednesday the 14th** we will have exchanges at the Waterfront plus mini-tours of no more than 30 people for each busload. We will visit the **San Francisco Center for the Book, Letterforms Archive,** and **Special Collections at the San Francisco Public Library**. Groups must remain small for each trip.

**Monday evening the 12th** there will be a talk and exhibition presented at the **Book Club of California (BCC)**. We will provide shuttle buses to and from the **BCC** for the lecture and reception. Participants may prefer the romantic & convenient 30-minute **San Francisco Bay Ferry** into the city -- the **Ferry** is only a 3-4 minute walk from the **Waterfront Hotel**.

**On Tuesday the 13th** we will have the opening reception of the main exhibition at the **American Bookbinders Museum (ABM)** -- shuttle buses will be provided although some participants may prefer the romance and convenience of the 30-minute **San Francisco Bay Ferry** into the city.

Wednesday the 14th the mini-tours and bookplate exchanges will continue in the morning. On Wednesday afternoon we are planning to have a catered San Francisco Bay cruise aboard the USS Potomac for 100 people. This was Franklin D. Roosevelt's Presidential Yacht (actually a small ship!) and it is only a 5-minute walk from the Waterfront Hotel.

**On Thursday morning the 15th** the exchanges will continue and the Delegates Meeting will take place. **Thursday evening** we will have the closing buffet banquet in the **Regatta Room at the Waterfront Hotel** and entertainment provided by the **OakTown Jazz Workshop** (<u>*https://bookplate2022.org/entertainment*</u>)

Bookplate exchanges and various "independent" recommended tours will continue through Saturday, September 17th. Such as: San Francisco City Tours, Napa Wine Country, Alcatraz Tours, Hearst Castle, Yosemite, University of California at Berkeley -- as you wish. These will all be posted on our "**Bookplates By The Bay**" website.
