I am sending you some information about the opening of the exhibition 27th International Biennial Exlibris of Modern – Malbork 2020.

„We invite you to see a selection of photos from the opening of the exhibition crowning the XXVII International Biennial of Contemporary Bookplate, which took place on June 5th in the Seven-Pillar Hall of the Malbork Castle. Congratulations once again to all the winners! From June 6th, the exhibition features 300 of the best contemporary book ownership marks. 1034 bookplates made by 324 artists from 37 countries were sent to the competition, while the exhibition presents bookplates selected by the Jury, i.e. 344 works made by 147 artists from 29 countries. A must for fans of graphics and books!
